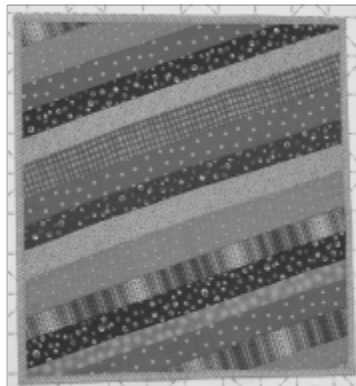

This is a quilt as you go doll quilt!

Baby Doll Blanket #1

Fabric Requirements/Cutting Instructions

Backing: 20" x 20" square

Batting: 20" x 20" square

Variety of fabric strips:

- Widths between 1-1/2" and 3"
- Length between 18" and 22"
- Quantity approximately 14 to 18 strips
(The quantity will vary based on the width of your strips.)

Binding: 1/4 yard accent fabric.

Cut three (3) 2-1/2" WOF strips.

(The actual amount is two and a half strips.)

Assembly

Iron your backing smooth.

Using either a temporary spray adhesive (or traditional basting methods) attach the wrong side of the backing fabric to one side of the batting square. Smooth out. When complete lay batting side up on your work station.

Take two (2) of the strips of different prints/colors and put them right sides together (RST) with two of the long sides matching. Place the short end of the strips on the lower left-hand corner of the batting/backing and run the strips diagonally across the quilt about 1/3 of the way up the right-hand side. (We have raised the right-hand side approx 5".)

Stitch the two strips RST 1/4" from the edge of the two (2) strips.

Now press the top strip up and away from the bottom strip.

Next put another strip of a different print/color RST on the top strip and another strip of a different print/color on the bottom strip having the edges matched and sew both strips 1/4" from the edge. Continue this stitch and flip method until the entire piece of batting is covered.

Finishing

Square up the quilt as close to the 20"x20" size as you can.

With your machine, attach the binding to the BACKSIDE of your doll blanket. Bring the binding to the FRONTSIDE and using a decorative topstitch, sew around the blanket. (Reason: if the binding is machine stitched to the blanket it will hold up for many, many washings.)

If you are more comfortable using a traditional binding method - please do so.

RST = right sides together

WOF = width of fabric

1/4" seam allowance used throughout the pattern.
